

Stamp Duty Land Tax – an overview of e-filing

In late 2005, HMRC introduced an e-filing system to enable solicitors and conveyancers to electronically submit SDLT Land Transaction Returns.

There has been a continual upward trend with customers enrolling for the online service. Since November 2006, customers receive an electronic version of the SDLT5 that can be printed off and sent to the Land Registers.

This seminar will explain the process from registration for the service through to receipt of an E certificate.

The presentation by HMRC speakers will give details of the benefits that e-filing can bring to your practice. They will give you an overview of the systems main screens and features and update you on enhancements.

HMRC will also give details of products and support available.

There will also be an opportunity for you to share your experiences of online filing and ask questions about e filing and general issues.

HMRC will collect information about your needs, preferences and processes in order to influence future strategies.
