



Conditions of Supply

1. "Secure Intermediate Electronic Transmission" in these Conditions of Supply means transmission by means of facsimile, Adobe Content Server System and such other systems of secure electronic transmission as the Society may from time to time agree at its discretion to use.
2. Where the Law Society supplies copied material under licence from the Copyright Licensing Agency Limited, then the terms in this Clause 2 shall apply.
 - 2.1 Copies may not be resold, hired out or otherwise disposed of for valuable consideration.
 - 2.2 Where a copy is supplied by Secure Intermediate Electronic Transmission it shall:
 - 2.2.1 immediately be printed out; or
 - 2.2.2 forwarded to the individual requesting the copy for their immediate printing;and in either case, all electronic versions shall immediately be deleted following successful transmission and printing.
 - 2.3 The Copyright Licensing Agency Limited may by virtue of the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999 enforce any term of these Conditions of Supply.
3. Where you have indicated on this form that you are requesting copied material for the purposes of judicial proceedings, then the terms in this Clause 3 shall apply.
 - 3.1 You warrant and undertake that the making by the Law Society of the copies you have requested and the supply to you by the Law Society of the said copies:
 - 3.1.1 will be for the purposes of judicial proceedings; and
 - 3.1.2 will not result in the infringement of any intellectual property rights, including copyright, of any third party.
 - 3.2 It is understood and agreed that there is no warranty and undertaking either express or implied on the part of the Law Society that copies supplied to you will be free from any infringement of any intellectual property rights, including copyright, of third any party.
4. You will indemnify the Law Society against all proceedings, costs, expenses, liabilities, loss or damage arising out of any breach or negligent performance or failure in performance by you of any of your obligations or warranties under these Conditions of Supply.
5. No variation in these Conditions of Supply shall be valid unless confirmed in writing by an authorised signatory of the Law Society.

These Conditions of Supply shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and both you and the Law Society agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.
