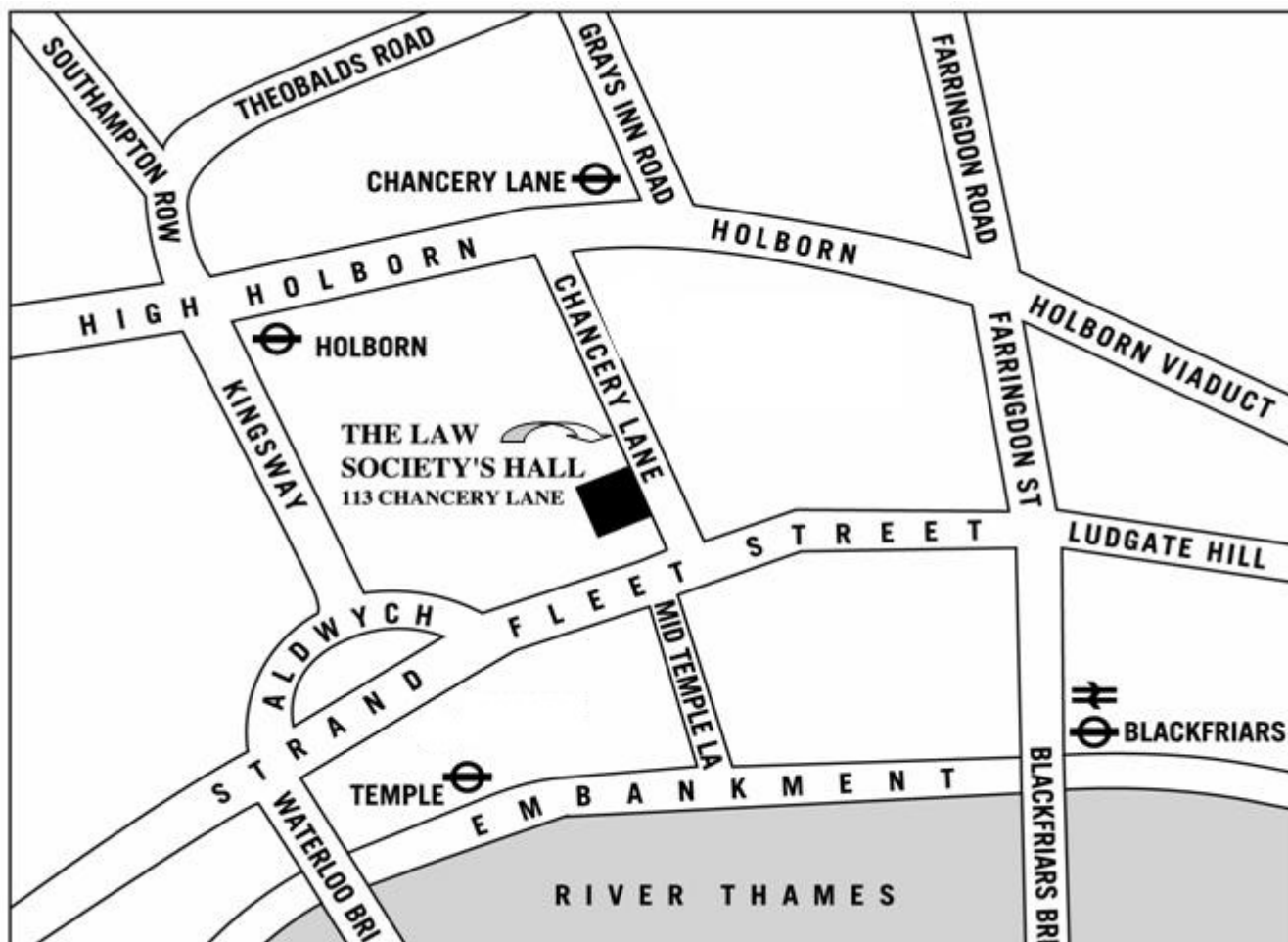

The Law Society's Hall

The Law Society building dates from 1823 and as in many period buildings of a similar age accessibility was not a priority at that time. However, we have made many changes and improvements in order to make our premises accessible to all.

We are committed to making your visit as easy and enjoyable as possible. Once in the building, if your needs cannot be met by the facilities provided, please ask the Front Desk staff for assistance as they will be happy to advise you.

Parking

Parking outside the Law Society is not allowed during the normal working day. All visitors should be dropped off or picked up from outside the main entrance. There are some parking meters in the vicinity. Parking is free after 1830 hours. The nearest two public disabled parking spaces are located at the junction of Chancery Lane and Southampton Buildings.

Entering the main building

An outside lift has been installed for disabled visitors from Chancery Lane to the reception area, sited adjacent to the Front Entrance steps. Please press the button to call the lift.

VISITING THE MAIN BUILDING

The Common Room

Wheelchair access is available to the Common Room via the front hall lift to the first floor. Turn sharp right on exiting the lift and through the door to the main staircase. The Common Room is straight ahead. (Not suitable for power-operated wheelchairs)

Visiting the Library*

Wheelchair access is available to the Library via the front hall lift to the first floor. Turn sharp right on exiting the lift and through the door to the main staircase. The entrance to the Library is on the right. Please inform reception on your arrival in order for Library staff to give you access via this route. (Not suitable for power-operated wheelchairs)

**Please note - the library is only open to members and their employees*

Bar & Restaurant

Six Clerks Restaurant & Bar is situated on the ground floor. The restaurant has a clear and level access. The bar is raised up three steps from the restaurant area. Law Society porters and Six Clerks staff are trained to assist visitors if requested.

Toilets

A toilet for use by visitors with disabilities is situated next to the cloakroom in the reception area on the ground floor. Additional facilities for disabled visitors are situated throughout the Law Society buildings, so please ask for directions.

Public telephones

A telephone for use by visitors with disabilities is located in the Reading Room. Please ask for directions.

Assisted hearing facility

Induction loops are available in Reception and all main function rooms for people with impaired hearing. Please switch your hearing aid to 'T' frequency.

Guide dogs

Guide dogs are welcome in all rooms.
